



# NATIONAL STEPS CHALLENGE™ SEASON 4 HEART-PUMPING ISLAND RACE WITH KLOOK TERMS & CONDITIONS

Date: 26 Jan 2019 (Saturday)

Venue: Emerald Pavilion @ Siloso Beach, Sentosa

Event Duration: 12pm - 6pm. Onsite check-in starts from 11.30am onwards at Emerald Pavilion.

Registration Period: From 7 Jan 2019, 0000 hours onwards (We may close registration earlier if all

500 slots are filled)

#### Participant Eligibility

1. This Challenge is only eligible for National Steps Challenge™ Season 4 – Youth Challenge participants. Participants must have both valid NRIC/FIN and Student Matriculation Card and at least 17 years old at the point of registration.

- 2. Participants must be a current student from the participating Institutes of Higher Learning (IHLs), as indicated below:

- 3. Eligible participants who are below 18 years of age must obtain parental consent before participating in this Challenge. You will receive the Letter of Parental Consent via your email address provided through the registration link. You are required to **bring the hardcopy Letter of Parental Consent when you check-in** on 26 Jan 2019.
- 4. Participants must form a team of 4 and register as a group for this Challenge from 7 January 2019, 0000 hours onwards. Kindly note that you only require 1 team member (preferably the Team Leader) to conduct the group registration by copying and pasting the registration link in the browser: <a href="https://heartpumpingislandracewithklook.eventbrite.sg">https://heartpumpingislandracewithklook.eventbrite.sg</a>.
- 5. Participants from NUS Ridge View Residential College (RVRC) are required to sign up at a separate link: https://rvrcheartpumpingislandracewithklook.eventbrite.sg.

- 6. After registration, please print out or obtain a screenshot of the event ticket for onsite check-in on 26 Jan 2019. Kindly remind the entire team (including yourself) to bring both valid NRIC/FIN and Student Matriculation Card for verification on 26 Jan 2019. For eligible persons below the age of 18 years old, please also bring the hardcopy Letter of Parental Consent.
- 7. Please note that by registering for this Challenge, your team members and yourself will be consenting to the Terms & Conditions of this Challenge.
- 8. Kindly note that for NUS RVRC participants, while they are permitted to form a team of 4 or 5 based on their project groups, only a maximum of 4 participants would be allowed to participate in both beach game stations and Klook merchant activities to ensure fairness for others. Similarly, only a maximum of up to 4 Klook travel vouchers would be awarded to each winning team.

## How to Register?

**Step 1:** Sign up for National Steps Challenge™ Season 4 – Youth Challenge on the Healthy 365 mobile app, if your team members and yourself have not done so.

**Step 2:** Form a team of 4, nominate a Team Leader and create a Team Name. Please note that only NUS RVRC students are permitted to form a team of 4 or 5.

**Step 3:** Team leader to register on behalf of the team members by copying and pasting the registration link in the browser: <a href="https://heartpumpingislandracewithklook.eventbrite.sg">https://heartpumpingislandracewithklook.eventbrite.sg</a>.

**Step 4:** Click on "Register" → "Create Team". You will be prompted to key in your Team Name.

**Step 5:** Select "4" under the number of tickets and click "Checkout". Please note that only NUS RVRC students are allowed to select "4" or "5" under the number of tickets

**Step 6:** Fill in the necessary fields to complete your group registration. The event ticket will be sent to your email. Please print out or obtain a screenshot of the event ticket for onsite check-in on 26 Jan 2019. Kindly remind the entire team (including yourself) to bring both valid NRIC/FIN and Student Matriculation Card for verification on 26 Jan 2019. For eligible persons below the age of 18 years old, please also bring the hardcopy Letter of Parental Consent.

#### Game Mechanics

This is a team-based challenge around Sentosa where **teams of 4** compete to earn the most points from a series of beach game stations and from Klook Hot Spots within 4 hours (i.e. time-based). Teams can strategise their game play based on the event map given and the points system shown below. **Please note that teams are required to travel around Sentosa together as a team and to gather back at Emerald Pavilion by 5.15pm for points tabulation.** 

There would be a total of 3 ways to earn points, as indicated below:
