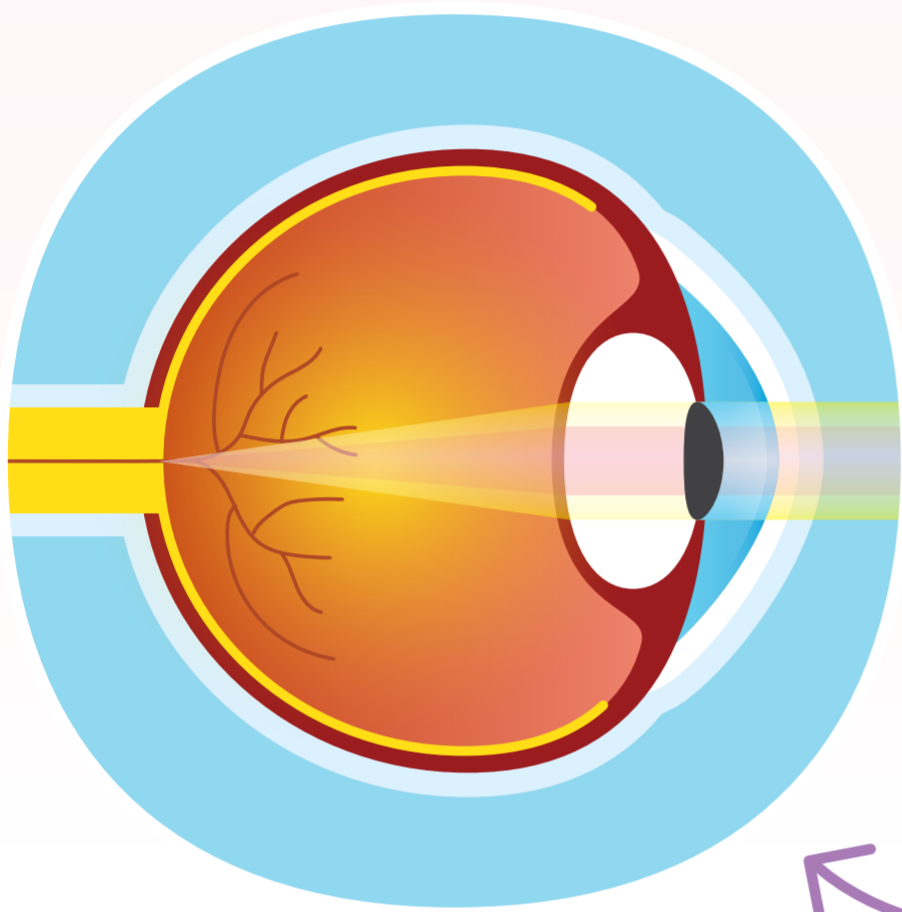


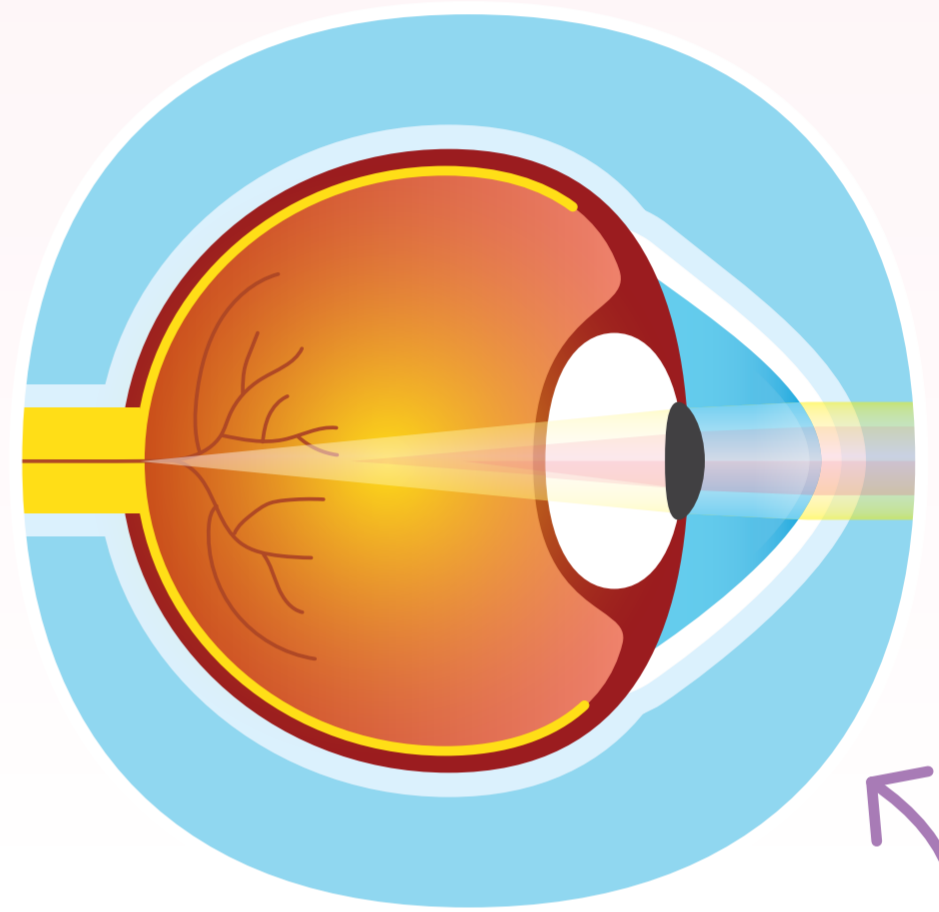
Does My Child Have Astigmatism?



Astigmatism is a condition that causes blurred vision due to irregular cornea shape



The eye is typically round like a ball



Astigmatism alters the shape of the cornea to become oval, scattering light – leading to blurred vision



Signs of astigmatism



Blurry vision



Squinting to see clearly



Headaches



Difficulty seeing at night
