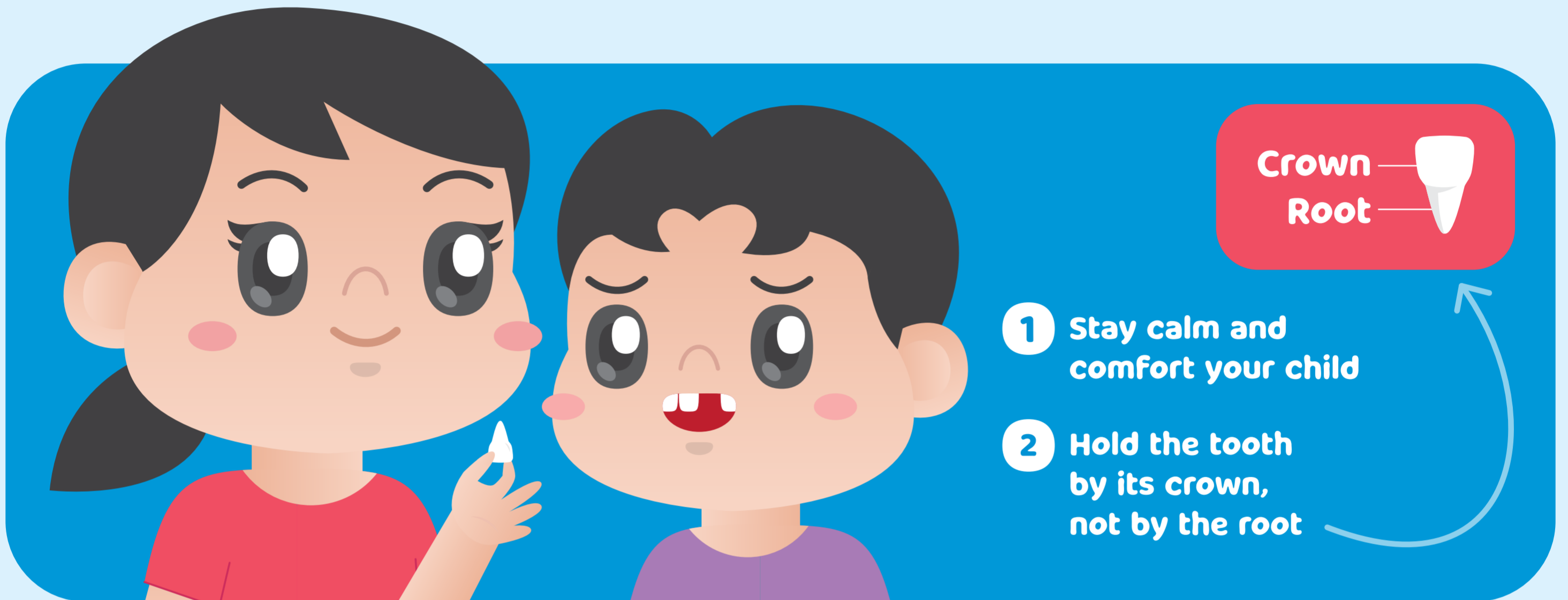


My Child's Permanent Tooth Was Knocked Out, What Should I Do?



Ideally, replant the tooth

If you prefer not to replant



- 3** Rinse off debris on tooth, avoid scrubbing the root



- 4** Place the tooth back into the socket and get your child to bite onto a handkerchief to hold the tooth in place



- 3** Keep the tooth in a glass of fresh milk (ideally) or saliva



- 4** Do not wrap the tooth in tissue paper

Take your child and the tooth to the dentist immediately.
